_____ I am aware of the signs and symptoms of infection, including, but not limited to redness, swelling, tenderness of the procedure site, red streaks going from the procedure site toward the heart, elevated body temperature, or purulent drainage from the procedure site.

_____ I understand there is a possibility of getting an infection as a result of receiving body art, particularly in the event that I do not take proper care of the procedure site.

_____ I will seek professional medical attention if signs and symptoms of infection occur.

_____ I agree to follow all instructions concerning the care of my tattoo, and that any touchups needed due to my own negligence will be done at my own expense.

_____ I understand that there is a chance that I might feel lightheaded or dizzy during or after being tattooed.

_____ I agree to immediately notify the artist in the event that I feel lightheaded, dizzy and/ or faint before, during, or after the procedure.

I, ________ have been fully informed of the risk of body art including but not limited to infection, scarring, difficulties in detecting melanoma, and allergic reactions to tattoo ink, latex gloves, and antibiotics. Having been informed of the potential risks associated with a body art procedure, I still wish to proceed with the body art application and I assumer any and all risk that may arise from body art.
